Policy

Principles

- Where possible and useful, consideration is given to how waste flows can be limited.
- The processes are designed in such a way, that environmental incidents can be prevented or, if necessary, managed.
- The policy must be realized within the budgetary possibilities of the organization.
- This policy is evaluated annually and, if necessary, adjusted to developments with regard to the relevant legislation and regulations and industrial standards.
- When drawing up the environmental objectives and updating them, the stated principles mentioned in this policy and the current state of technology are taken into account.
- The Allinq Group strives to make the chain more sustainable by seeking innovative solutions together with clients and suppliers, that contribute to the sustainability objectives of those involved.
- The Allinq Group strives to make the entire sector more sustainable by participating in networks and industrial meetings.

Objectives



The Allinq Group aims to:

- have reduced the total CO₂ emissions in 2020 by ten percent compared to emissions in 2016¹. The focus is mainly on reducing CO₂ emissions as a result of the electricity and gas consumption in the buildings and the fleet;
